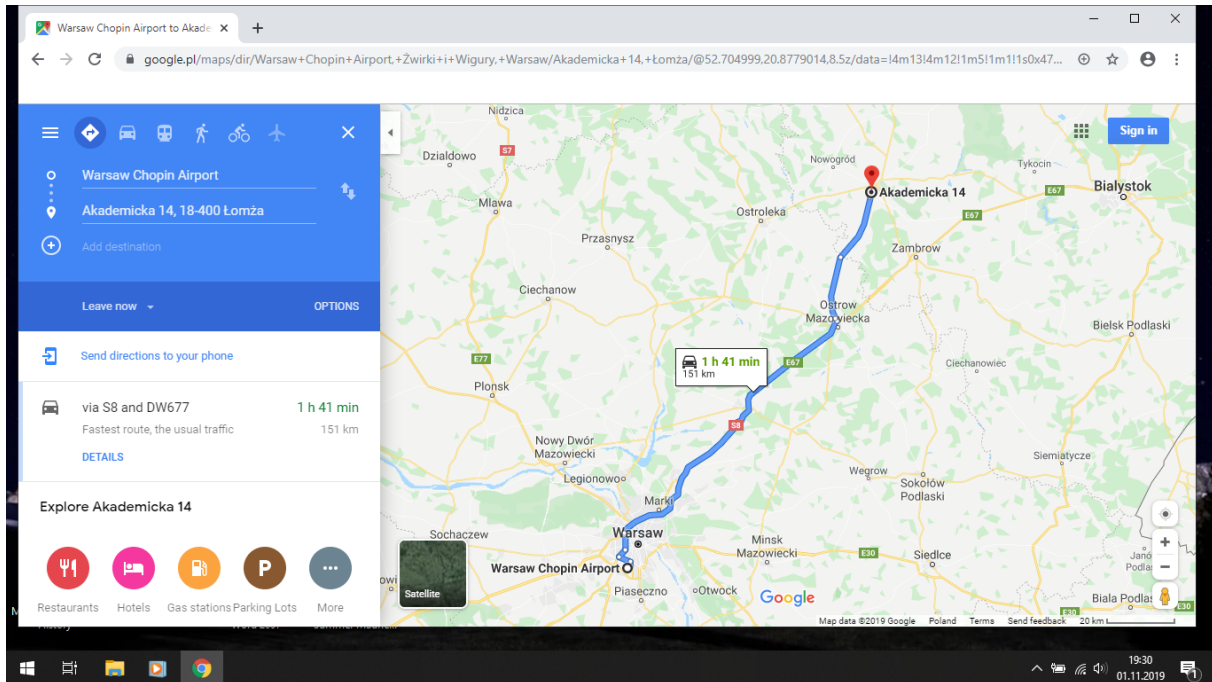

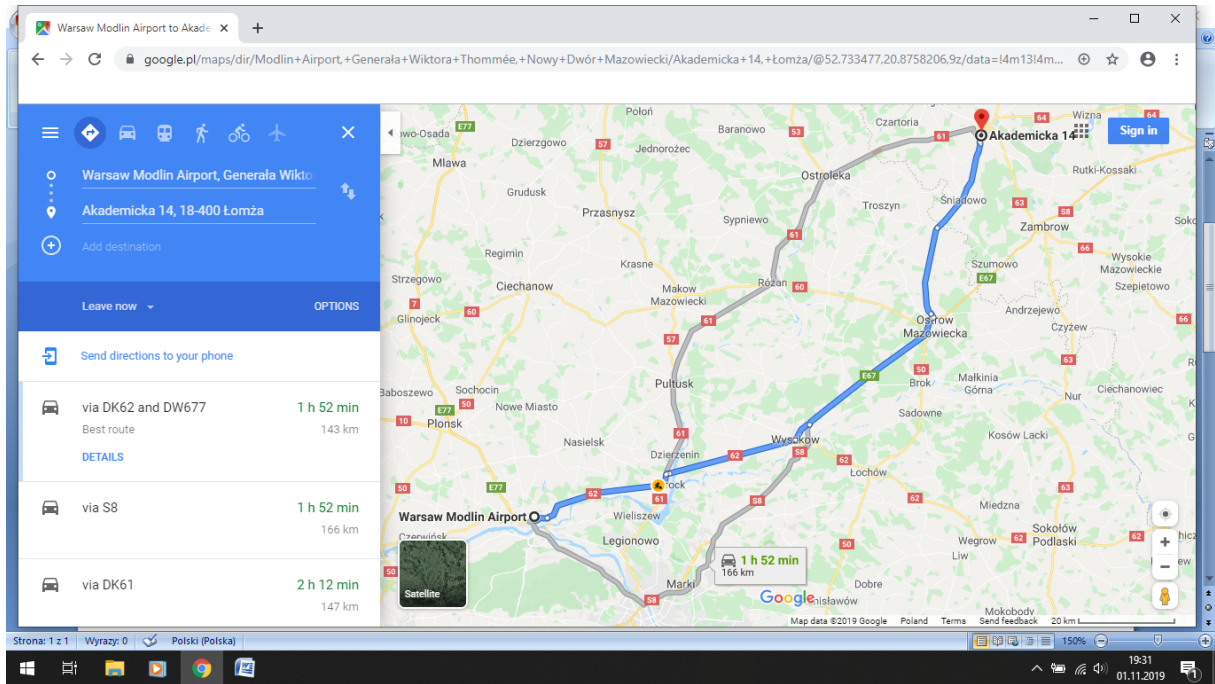
The route from Warsaw Chopin Airport

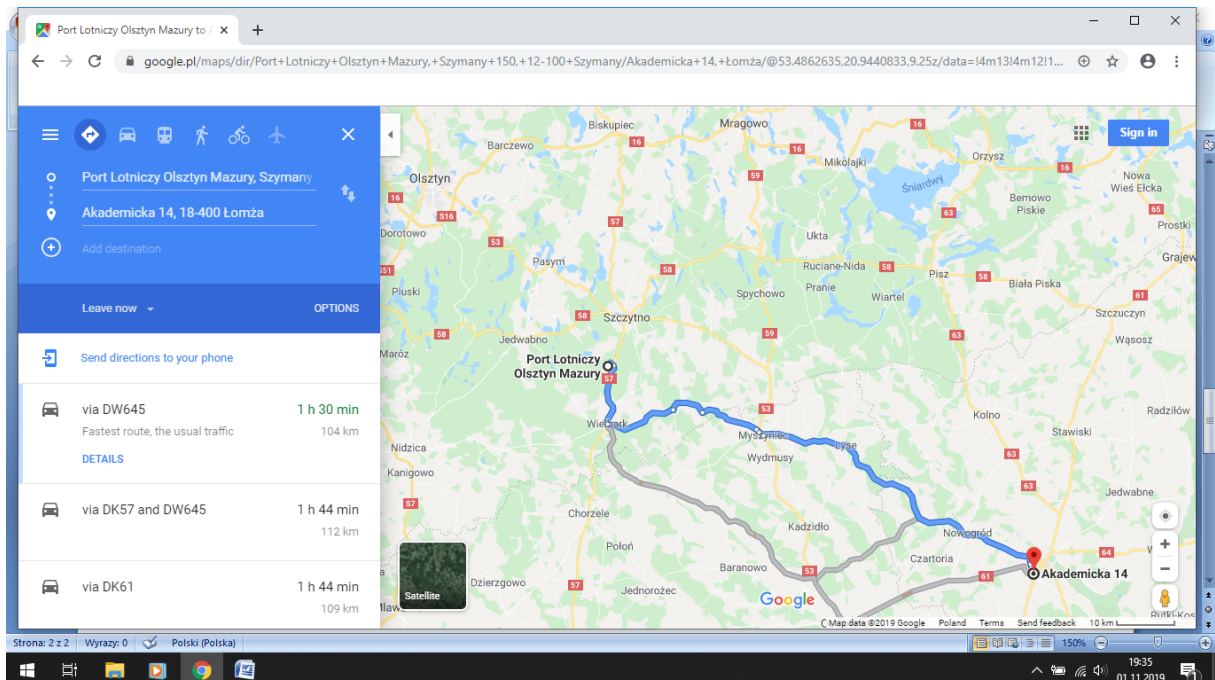
The route from Warsaw Modlin Airport

By car

The journey from each airport takes from 1.5 up to 2 hours. Traffic drives on the right. Petrol and gas are available at all filling stations. The Polish Motoring Association (Polski Związek Motorowy-PZM) can be called on 981 nationwide for assistance. Renting a car is available at the airports or through various car rental offices in Warsaw, Szymany and in Łomża. Charges are usually based on a daily rate plus a kilometre charge. Seat belts are mandatory. When you arrive at the venue of the conference, it is best to leave your car in one of the car parks situated around the building on Akademicka 14.

By bus

The best option is to book a seat on a bus through the website:

There are direct buses from Warsaw Chopin and Warsaw Modlin Airports to Łomża Coach Station. Travelling from Olsztyn Mazury Airport means changing a bus at the Coach Station in Szczytno; first, taking a shuttle from the airport (about 10 km) and then a bus which passes by through Szczytno to Łomża. Fares can be made via online transfers or by credit cards. The ticket can be sent either to your email account or a mobile phone.
